

Getting ReelUse Desktop onto your computer.

The desktop app reads the recording where it already sits, so the full video stays on your machine. Audio and finished clips are uploaded; selected video segments also upload if cloud rendering is needed. **It is in early access, so there is no download button yet.** You ask, and we send you the file.

GETTING THE APP

- 1 Ask for it**
Go to reeluse.com/downloads and press Get the app. It opens your email. Tell us Mac or Windows. A person replies with your file and setup help.
- 2 Open the file**
On a Mac you get a **.dmg**. Open it and drag **ReelUse Desktop** into your Applications folder. On Windows you get an installer. Run it and follow the prompts.
- 3 If your computer refuses to open it**
This is normal for an early access build and does not mean anything is wrong. **On a Mac**, right click the app and choose Open, then Open again. **On Windows**, if you see "Windows protected your PC", choose More info, then Run anyway. You only do this the first time.
- 4 Sign in**
Press **Sign in with browser**. Your browser opens, you sign in to your normal ReelUse account, and the app picks it up. There is no separate desktop account.
- 5 Add your first talk**
Press **Add a talk**, then choose your recording. It accepts **mp4** **mov** **mkv** **m4v** **webm** **avi**. Set the part to analyse, then let it run.

WILL IT RENDER ON YOUR MACHINE, OR IN THE CLOUD?

The app checks your computer on first launch and shows what it found. Both routes give you the same clips. The difference is only where the work happens.

YOUR COMPUTER

WHERE CLIPS ARE MADE

Mac with Apple Silicon (M1 and later)	On your computer. The recording never leaves it.
Intel Mac	In the cloud. The app says so rather than pretending.
Windows with 4 or more cores and at least 6.5 GB of RAM	On your computer.
Windows below that	In the cloud.

Ignore the "hardware encode" chip. The app reports it for diagnostics. Every render uses the processor on both platforms, so it does not change what happens.

TWO THINGS PEOPLE ASK ON DAY ONE

Is this a different account?

No. Same account, same library, same plan. Every talk you run here shows up on the web, and the other way round.

Does it update itself?

Not yet. While it is in early access we send you a new file when there is one worth having.
